

Nobel Prize Current Event Report Guidelines

- Select one newspaper article: medicine, physics or chemistry.
- Read and cross-reference information in the news article with information on the Nobel Prize website.
- Create a 350 word report on the Nobel prize and the winner
- First page should contain a proper heading (name, class, date) in upper right hand corner.
- Create a unique and interesting title for your report and center it at the top of the report
- Begin with an introduction that contains information about the Nobel Prizes and what they are. Text wrap one image from the internet inside the introduction
- The second paragraph must contain one table that contains personal information about the winner(s) and a few sentences about the scientists. Include one quote from the scientist(s) or a quote about the work they have done. You may need to cross-reference their names with other Internet articles about them.
- The next paragraph(s) must describe the research and what techniques were used to advance science. Include another image in this section of the report.
- Your conclusion should contain information about how this area of research benefits others in the world. You must have a minimum of five sentences about your personal interpretation of the scientist(s) work.
- References cited at the bottom of the page.
